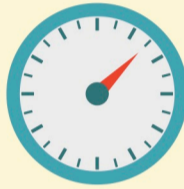


**1 Accountability and Fairness**  
Unlike traditional water gauges, water meters allow the supply system to demonstrate accountability and a fair distribution

**2 Water Conservation**  
By monitoring the volume of water consumed, users can identify inefficient water consumption behaviors and adjust for them

## Why are water meters important?



**3 Cost Implications**  
Water meters make it possible to charge customers based on their actual water consumption

**4 Water Management**  
Water meters contribute to the reduction of non-revenue water caused by leaks, breaks, thefts..., at the level of the distribution network

### What can you do at home ?

**You can know how much water you use in a month**  
By reading the meter at the beginning and the end of the month, you can compare the two totals



**You can check for leaks**  
Turn off all the household taps and look at the meter.  
If it keeps on turning, this means that there is a leak in the house
