
The industrial sector in Lebanon is an important source of water pollution

Reusing or recycling water

Using grey water for non-potable applications

Treating effluents minimally for repeated use

Replacing small components or upgrading existing equipment

Performing routine maintenance on leaking equipment and pipes

e.g. low volume high-pressure nozzles and spray heads for rinsing production units
