Supported by the "Asfari Foundation", this 1st Entrepreneurship Lab featured a panel discussion as well as 3 breakout sessions about 3 different topics: Energy,

It gathered both sector actors and the public sector representatives in addition to key experts in each field, as well as entrepreneurs themselves, who were given space to outline their work and exchange potential opportunities. The panel discussion and the sessions were very interactive and interesting; the key experts were there to share their top-notch experience, and the moderators ensured a high level of engagement. Participants provided a positive feedback in regards to the chosen topics, the material, and the remarkable discussion, especially during the recycling session.

The Chair of "Fondation Diane" in Education for Eco-Citizenship & Sustainable Development (CEEDD) organized on 10 June 2021, a zoom webinar entitled: "Environmental Citizenship in Light of Digitization: Any Opportunities for Change".

It was moderated by Dr. Ali Khalifeh, Professor of Citizenship Education at the Faculty of Education- Lebanese University, and Advisory member in Education for Citizenship at USJ.

The Webinar was very interactive, and the participants were able to: (1) Recognize the link between environmental citizenship and economic and political choices,
